Vineyard planted in 1940

*Les Pâquerettes, subtle, ethereal, delicate
and with a great floral expression. Fresh
and fluid on the palate.*

Variety: Malbec

Terroir: La Consulta

Soils: Deep, silty and cold. They generate floral profiles.

Vineyard: Tomal ("ancient" in the Huarpe language)

Aging: 15 months in French oak barrels. 30% new.



WITH ITS GRAND CRUS, BODEGA TEHO
PAYS TRIBUTE TO BURGUNDY, WHERE 1300
YEARS AGO PEOPLE STARTED TO DEFINE
THE DIFFERENT "CLIMATS" OF THEIR
TERROIR, DIFFERENCING AND CREATING A
DEVELOPED MAP OF PARCELS THAT TODAY
REPRESENT THE EMBLEMATIC AND WORLD-
RENOWNED GRAND CRUS.

INSPIRED IN BURGUNDY, OUR OLD
VINEYARD TOMAL IN LA CONSULTA, WE
STUDIED THE DIFFERENT SOILS THAT
COMPOSE THIS 4-HECTARE VINEYARD.
YEAR AFTER YEAR WE CONTINUE TO LEARN
AND UNDERSTAND THE INFLUENCE THAT
EACH SOIL TYPE HAS INTO THE WINE. FOR
THIS REASON, WE CREATED THREE
DIFFERENT WINES FROM THREE DIFFERENT
SOIL PROFILES WITHIN THE SAME
VINEYARD. SAME VINIFICATIONS RESULT IN
DIFFERENT STYLES OF WINE ACCORDING
TO EACH PARTICULAR SOIL PROFILE.
